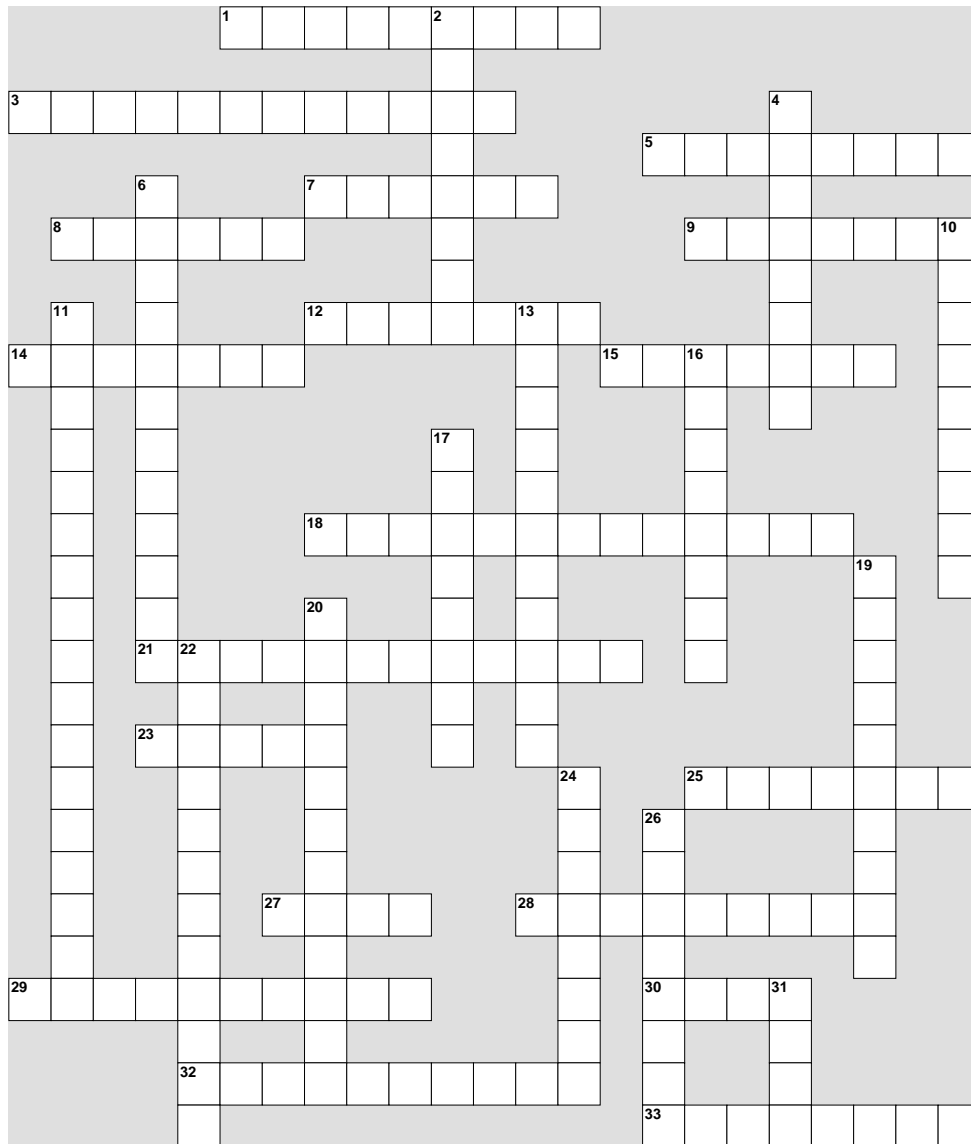


EMDR Research Foundation 2015 Crossword Puzzle

- 1 In addition to other valuable research resources, the EMDR Early Intervention Researcher's Toolkit provides specific group and individual EMDR ___ for use with recent trauma and disaster.
- 3 In a ___, the combined results of published studies are analyzed to find the trend of results on a research question. Maxfield and Hyer's (2002) study reported the more rigorous the research and EMDR therapy treatment fidelity, the larger the effect size.
- 5 In the past year, studies receiving the Foundation's ___ Award have included breast cancer, depression, co-occurring PTSD & addiction, neurobiological basis of EMDR, PTSD & moral injury in veterans, and fibromyalgia.
- 7 An Institutional ___ Board (IRB) is charged with protecting the rights and welfare of people involved in research.
- 8 "Addressing the Global Burden of ___" is the second research priority of the Foundation.

- 12 The EMDR Early Intervention Researcher's ___ was released in 2015 to make it easier and more likely that clinicians responding to recent trauma and disaster situations will use a standardized approach in EMDR research.
- 14 The Francine Shapiro ___ is an online compendium of scholarly articles and other published resources related to AIP and EMDR.
- 15 The initials of the quarterly, peer-reviewed journal that shares research and theory about EMDR in clinical practice.
- 18 The Foundation's Research ___ Travel Award was awarded to Lindsay Bira to present her research "Determining person-treatment fit for brief treatment of trauma in a community setting: Which interventions are best for whom?" at last fall's ISTSS Conference.

- 21 Pagani, Amann, Hermans, & van der Kolk all received funding from the Foundation for studies that may reveal the mechanism of action of EMDR. Their studies use ___ to measure changes in the brain.
- 23 Andrew ___, PhD is the editor of the "Recent Research Articles in EMDR"; a column in the EMDRIA Newsletter and accessible on the Foundation's website.
- 25 SAMHSA's National Registry of Evidence Based Programs and Practices endorsed EMDR for treatment of PTSD, depression and ___ symptoms in 2010. High quality research studies were essential for achieving this status.
- 27 Series of ___ studies suggest EMDR therapy is helpful with somatic conditions including body dysmorphic disorder, chronic pain, and phantom limb pain; but to date no RCT's have been published for these conditions.
- 28 As a 501c3 nonprofit established in 2006, ___ to the EMDR Research Foundation are tax deductible.

- 29 Known as "EDEN," this multi-center randomized controlled clinical trial brings together researchers throughout Europe to compare CBT with EMDR therapy in the treatment of recurrent ___.
- 30 Translating Research Into Practice ("___") articles are designed to make research relevant and accessible to clinicians. These articles share clinical case examples that support or illustrate the results of a referenced research study - without the need for data collection.
- 32 The award for the Research Grants offered by the Foundation have increased from ten to ___ thousand dollars.
- 33 "Advancing ___ Based Practice" is the first of the Foundation's research priorities.

- 2 The Foundation's third research priority is "Building ___ Evidence."
- 4 Applications for the \$25K Research Award and the \$5K Dissertation Award are due the first day of ___ and July.
- 6 She replicated Dr. Shapiro's 1989 study in her dissertation research. In 2015, the Foundation renamed its \$5000 dissertation grant in her honor.
- 10 Some controlled studies include a comparison of EMDR Therapy with "TAU", which stands for "___ as usual."
- 11 These donors give at least \$15 each month, and are the Foundation's greatest funding source. (2 words)
- 13 The Adaptive ___ Processing theory explains and predicts the treatment effects seen with EMDR therapy.
- 16 The "___ in Action" newsletter provides EMDR therapy research findings to support the clinical practice of clinicians working with clients serving in the armed forces, veterans, and their families.
- 17 The "Cliff Notes" of research articles.
- 19 A research method in which the client serves as his/her own control group; this type of research may be the first step to build evidence for clinical innovations or new applications of EMDR. (2 words)
- 20 Applications are accepted year round for the Foundation's \$1000 research ___ award, to advance development, completion, or publication of an EMDR therapy research project.
- 22 Lee & Cuijpers 2013 meta-analysis of 15 clinical and 11 laboratory trials explored the impact of ___ on the processing of emotional memories. (2 words)
- 24 EMDR therapy performed significantly better than imaginal ___ in treating PTSD, depression & anxiety symptoms following life threatening cardiac events (2011).

- 31 While the strongest empirical support for EMDR therapy is in treating ___, the Foundation aims to fund research that expands this base of knowledge to other disorders and populations.
