	Trauma and Resiliency Resources' Warrior Camp® program is a groundbreaking approach to treating Combat Trauma in active military and veterans of all eras. The weeklong intensive, residential program utilizes twice daily EMDR Therapy, EAGALA-model Equine Assisted Psychotherapy, Yoga, and Narrative Writing, in the context of community. Clinical data from 6 programs has been collected pre and post treatment and will be collected from the 7th program in October 2015. Data consists of 9 clinical screening tools, some clinician-administered and some participant self reports. The hypothesis is that the complexity of combat trauma (including the separate and distinct manifestations of PTSD, Military Sexual Trauma and Moral Injury) require a multi-modality approach to heal the trauma of war. The goals of the study are to document outcomes of an integrated treatment approach. No. of participants so far = 51.
